RADM KONETZNI/USS KAMEHAMEHA/HONOLULU ADVERTISER. Mike Gordon covered KAMEHAMEHA decommissioning ISO personal profile on RADM Konetzni, who spoke there. Negotiating story currently.

USS PORTSMOUTH/POLK MAGAZINE. POLK editor, Alex Liu embarked USS PORTSMOUTH 15 DEC ISO article on CO, CDR Rick Low. POLK magazine is targeted at the Asian American market. Story to run in issue out in late February.

SSNs/SSBNs/KAPLAN BOOK REQUEST. UK author, Philip Kaplan (author of "Fighter Pilot" and "Bombers") working on a book about submarines. CHINFO/CSP approved project. CSPRWC working with author on imagery and interviews. Navy News Photo met with author the week of 18 Sept. Embarked USS JEFFERSON CITY on 21 September with Dependants cruise. Interviewed submariners 20-24 September including VADM Hannifin (ret.) and CO USS SALT LAKE CITY. SSBN embark arranged by CSG-9 PAO, as well as visit to Bangor area from 9-11 January. Author requesting follow-up support from CSS-11 (Submarine "Zippos" and menu cards). Items mailed this week.

SSBN FAMILY MEMBER/THE LEARNING CHANNEL. The spouse of a USS Alabama crewmember is the subject of a documentary on weight loss. TLC is scheduled to videotape the ship's next homecoming.

USS SALT LAKE CITY/TBS/WARGAMES. TBS crew filmed aboard USS SALT LAKE CITY with host Anne Powell ISO the show "Wargames". The program highlights the exercise WOLFPACK. One film crew also embarked a Torpedo Retriever for two days of filming. Show to air in March.

CSS-11/SDUT. CSS-11 is partnering with the Marine Room restaurant for cross training with their chef and Mess Specialists. SDUT Food Editor is interested in running a front page (of the Food section) article highlighting the partnership. Tentatively scheduled for 15 March embark with chef and SDUT editor.

DSU/BBC. Deep Submergence Unit received two requests from different BBC programs; Blue Peter and Natural History, to film the DSRV and ADS. Referred the requests to CHINFO. Researching camera certification for DSRV.

USS BREMERTON/KPBS RADIO. Reporter with KPBS Radio San Diego who interviewed CO of USS BREMERTON during San Diego Fleet Week has requested an embark ISO a story on a Day in the Life of a submariner. Targeting embark 16 March.

USS PORTSMOUTH/SSN/OFF LIMITS/PBS. "Off Limits," KVIE's series for PBS has requested support for a "Day in the Life on a submarine" story. Filming took place 20-21 November on board USS PORTSMOUTH. Piece to air in Summer 2001.

USS GREENEVILLE/SSNs/TRAVEL CHANNEL. Andrew Yex of LMNOTV producing show called "Secrets of..." focusing on island of Oahu and Pearl Harbor from 7-14 December. Filmed on GREENEVILLE and interviewed RADM Konetzni. Also working to provide approval of undock of GREENEVILLE.

SUBMARINES/COX NEWSPAPERS. Bob Keefe works for Cox newspapers requests support for submarine technology stories. Currently considering his request. He is open to other technology stories aside from submarines. List of papers: <http://www.coxnews.com/newspapers/index.html>

USS HONOLULU/SSNs/PBS WARSHIPS. Grenada Television toured HONOLULU ISO "Warships" documentary series. The series consists of four, one-hour documentaries, one of which will be on submarines. HONOLULU demonstrated prosecution of surface target, and provided a walk-around with the Commanding Officer CDR John Richardson. CHINFO approved rough cut. Submarine documentary will start by including footage of HONOLULU crew, then take viewer through the history of submarine warfare, and then end up back on HONOLULU. To run later in 2001.

CSPREP WC/"RESCUE OF USS SQUALUS". NBPL assisted location scout David Wermus from "The Terrible Hours" (TV movie about the loss and rescue of USS Squallus). Wermus is taking still photos of potential sites for use in filming movie on Submarine Base San Diego. Sites include historic Senior Officer Quarters currently under restoration, historic barracks and office buildings, Qtrs. A, FISC Fuel pier, USS Roncador Submarine Memorial and other sites on the base. Project coordinated by NAVINFO West.

USS SALT LAKE CITY/DISCOVERY CHANNEL/SPACE MEDICINE. Film crew interviewed IDC and CSS-11 MD on board USS SALT LAKE CITY WRT use of a Light Emitting Diode (LED) to treat lacerations on SALT LAKE CITY's last deployment. Interview focused on high technology on board submarines and the Navy always looking for ways to improve life for Sailors. The LED is being tested for medical use on Space Shuttle missions.

USS HAWKBILL/SCICEX-99. National Geographic Explorer will include SCICEX as part of a three-hour documentary to run Spring 2001. Big Wave Productions copied footage ISO another National Geographic effort (separate production company than Explorer folks), footage returned. Pioneer Productions (British Channel 5) working one-hour documentary entitled "The North Pole is Melting" in which they will include footage taken during SCICEX. Swedish TV is also working report on sea floor, and plans to include footage from HAWKBILL.

USS HOUSTON/USS PHOENIX ASSOC. USS PHOENIX Association has requested to adopt USS HOUSTON. The organization has remained strong despite the decommissioning of USS PHOENIX. Referred to CO USS HOUSTON for support.

USS ASHEVILLE/NAMESAKE VISIT. CO and junior officer to make visit to Texas A&M for CNET, followed by visit by CO to Asheville ISO namesake visit. CSP investigating alternative funding for other crewmembers to accompany CO to namesake.



Aloha,

Welcome to the Pacific Fleet Submarine Force. You are scheduled to embark on an attack submarine for a daylight underway on Friday, February 9, 2001.

Please arrive at the Nimitz Gate parking lot no later than 0730 a.m. A map is enclosed for your convenience. We will greet and escort you onto the base. Available parking on the submarine base is at a minimum, so please car pool if possible.

Please note that the agenda is contingent upon the submarine's schedule. Although the time and date are confirmed, there may be a chance that the agenda may be subject to modification. We will try to notify you in advance of any changes.

There may be a possibility that you will be disembarking the submarine while it is underway. We will shuttle you from the submarine back to shore on a smaller boat, if necessary.

Security requires our office to supply the submarine with names and social security numbers of our guests several days prior to the scheduled embark. Someone from our office will be contacting you or your point of contact for this information.

General and clothing guidelines are enclosed for your information. If you are a non-Federal government employee, please complete the enclosed Naval Station Waiver and Release of Liability and bring it with you on the day of embarkation.

Refreshments are available and lunch will be served onboard for approximately \$3.20 per person. The ship's store may also have memorabilia available for purchase.

The Department of the Navy has no specific authority to use its funds to defray or reimburse a Navy guest for his or her personal expenses. As a result, the Department cannot provide you with transportation from your home to the port of

embarkation or from the port of embarkation back to your residence. Please make provisions to meet any expenses that may arise.

Please note that Navy ships and aircraft, by their very nature, present certain hazards not normally encountered ashore. These hazards require persons on board to exercise a high degree of care for their own safety.

Acceptance of this invitation will be considered your understanding of the above limitations and arrangements.
