1. Per references (a) and (b), Commander, Navy Region Hawaii is a Temporary Lodging Allowance (TLA) Authority. Based on reference (c), I have determined that TLA is necessary in the case of service members and their dependents living in communities serviced by the U.S. Navy water system.
2. Service members and their dependents living in communities serviced by the U.S. Navy water system may seek TLA through their command.
3. Service members and their dependents living in communities serviced by the U.S. Navy water system may also contact the Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam Emergency Operations Center (EOC) Information Hotline to request lodging at (808) 449-1979, (808) 448-3262, (808) 448-2557, (808) 448-2570, or (808) 448-2583.
4. TLA is restricted by reference (b) to service members and their families. DoD civilian employees and their dependents, non-affiliated civilians, and Active Duty dependents not accompanying member will be provided separate travel orders in accordance with reference (d).
5. This authorization extends reference (e) and will expire two calendar days after the appropriate housing office sends notification to residents that the zone has been flushed and the Department of Health has certified that the drinking water is safe for human consumption. Extension requests for unusual or extraordinary circumstances should be forwarded with supporting documentation by the unit commander to the EOC. Individual determinations are required to be in writing and copies will be forwarded to the appropriate pay system manager for auditing. Zone information is currently available on the official website <https://www.cpf.navy.mil/JBPHH-Water-Updates/>. Department of Health certification letters will be placed on the website and emailed by the appropriate housing office to the email on file.
